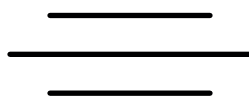

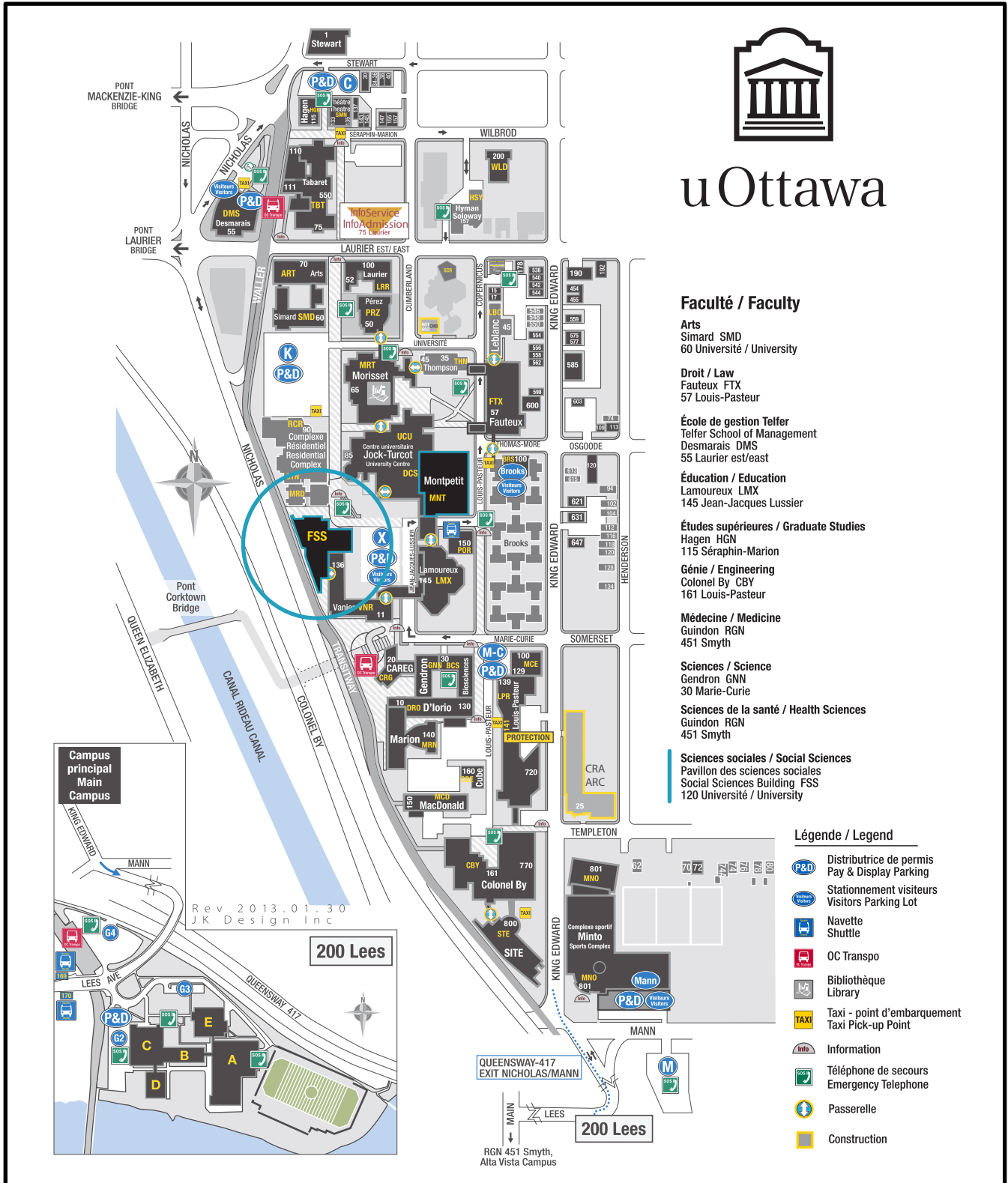

## CAMPUS PRINCIPAL / MAIN CAMPUS



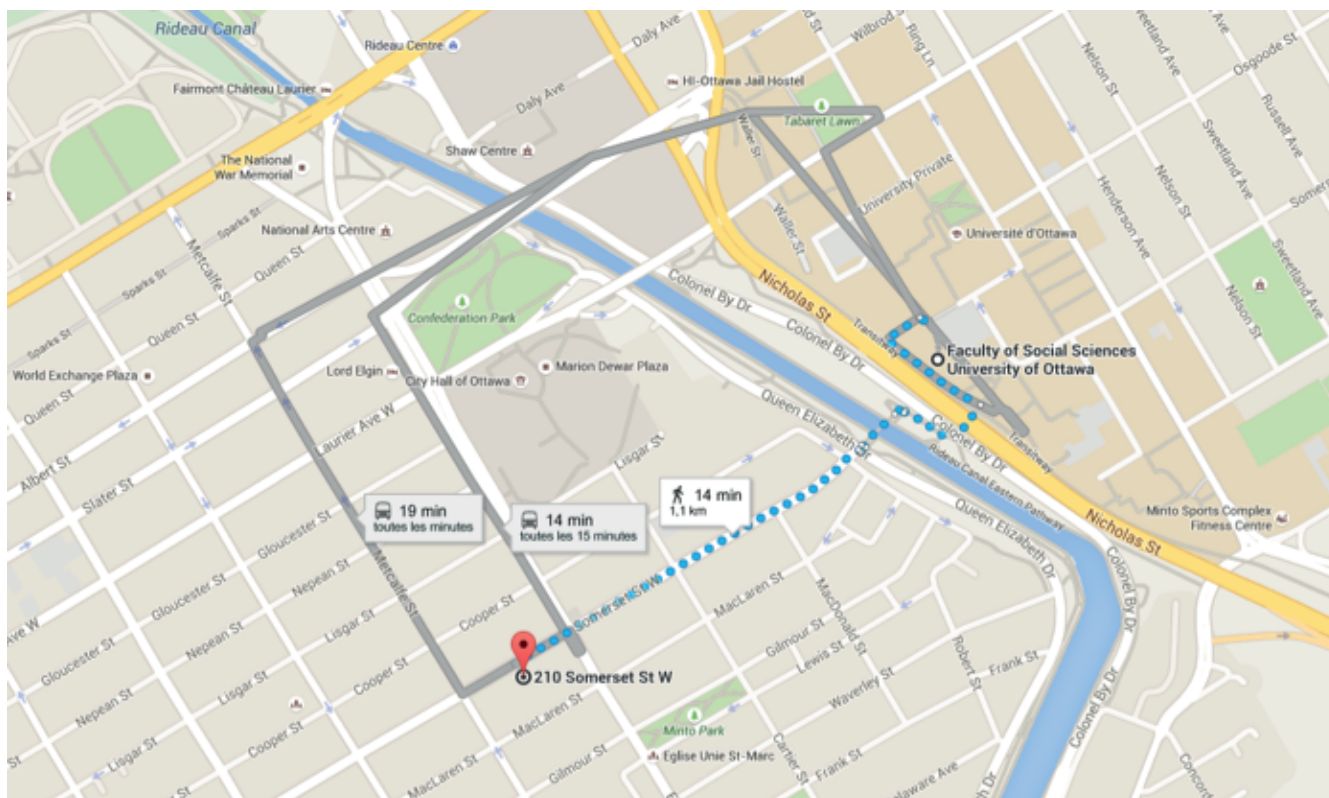
