The Canadian Society for the History of Medicine / Société canadienne d'histoire de la médecine seeks a new co-editor for its journal, *Canadian Bulletin of Medical History / Bulletin canadien d'histoire de la médecine*. The *CBHM/BCHM* is published twice a year by the journals division of the University of Toronto Press.

The ideal candidate will be able to continue the high standards of the publication and promote the journal in Canada and internationally. The co-editor will be an established scholar affiliated with a Canadian university, with a solid record of publication in peer-reviewed journals in Canada and abroad. The co-editor will also have broad interests in the history of medicine, an appreciation for diverse theoretical approaches and methodologies, and knowledge of the major intellectual issues and trends in the discipline. The candidate must have excellent communications skills, and enjoy working collaboratively with their co-editor, contributors to the journal, and the *CBMH/BCHM* Editorial Board.

The *CBMH/BCHM* publishes articles in both English and French, and the ability to work in both official languages would be an asset. All qualified candidates are encouraged to submit their application (or nomination of a candidate) directly to Peter.Twohig@smu.ca on or before 15 February 2019. Applications for the position of co-editor should be accompanied by a cover letter outlining the candidate's plans for the journal and a brief, two page current curriculum vitae. The Selection Committee warmly encourages applications from Indigenous people, persons with a disability, racially visible persons, women, persons of minority sexual orientations and gender identities, and all candidates who would contribute to the diversity of the Editorial Board.
